Facts and figures

- ▶ Around 6,000 companies operate in Germany's waste management industry, employing more than 200,000 people.
- ▶ With a share of around 25 percent, Germany is the world's leading exporter of closed cycle management technologies.
- ▶ In 2003 the dynamic on the international markets for recycling and disposal technologies accelerated significantly with around 21 percent per year.



- ▶ Between 2004 and 2006, German companies achieved an 11 percent growth in turnover.
- ▶ Investments needed in waste management for the period 2007 to 2020, e.g. in Russia, Turkey and ASEAN countries, are estimated at around 44 billion euro.
- ▶ Exports are expected to generate production in Germany to a value of around 9.7 billion euro.
